Hillsboro Airport Roundtable Exchange Meets June 29

Hillsboro Airport Roundtable Exchange plans a public workshop and regular meeting Wednesday, June 29 in rooms 113 B and C at City of Hillsboro Civic Center, 150 E. Main Street. The public is invited.

The workshop from 5:30-6:30 p.m. invites the community to participate in interactive small-group discussions on topics of community interest in advance of the upcoming update of the Hillsboro Airport Master Plan.

Among topics of the regular meeting from 7-8:45 p.m. is a presentation from Washington County regarding air quality and a recent report analyzing lead fuel emissions at Hillsboro Airport. Public comment periods are scheduled at 7:45 p.m. and 8:40 p.m.

Free parking is available, and the site is accessible by the TriMet MAX Blue Line at the Hatfield Government Center Station.

Hillsboro Airport Roundtable Exchange is a 22-member advisory group to the Port of Portland, formed to enhance and facilitate communication among people interested in the airport. Committee members represent the airport's diverse stakeholders such as nearby residents, neighboring businesses, airport tenants and users, and local jurisdictions.
