Open House on Future of Troutdale Airport Feb. 24

Citizens are invited to a Feb. 24 open house to learn more about planning and development alternatives for Troutdale Airport. Representatives from the Port of Portland will be available to discuss the project, “Troutdale Airport: Shaping Our Future,” from 4:30-5:30 p.m. at McMenamins Edgefield Main Ballroom, 2126 SW Halsey Street in Troutdale. The public is encouraged to attend the Troutdale Airport Master Plan Project Advisory Committee meeting following the open house from 6-9 p.m. to learn more about the project and provide public comment.

The committee will consider the future of the airport and surrounding property, and continue its discussion of development alternatives. The full meeting [agenda](#) is available at www.pdx.com.

The Port started the two-year master planning process for Troutdale Airport in June 2014. The study will assist the Port in determining what role the 278-acre airport will play in meeting the Port’s mission.

The project will provide a better understanding of the complex relationship between aviation uses at Troutdale Airport and other nearby airports, especially Portland International; and the surrounding land uses, both current and projected.

Meeting is a 22-member planning advisory committee, which includes airport tenants, community members, and business and government representatives from Troutdale, Fairview and Gresham.

Free parking is available, and the site is accessible by TriMet bus line #77. More information about the meeting is available by calling Chris White at 503.415.6056.
