22 management, and information about how airplanes are managed in and out of PDX.

26 The annual UC Davis Noise Symposium will be held in February in Tucson Arizona this year –
27 February 27 – March 2, 2011.

30 will include panel discussion of methodology for community outreach and engagement. The
31 panel will include residents from communities impacted by aircraft noise. Kelly Sweeny was
32 invited to participate as a speaker on the panel. Kelly will discuss the PDX outreach programs
33 and CNAC's role as an advisory committee representing the community.

36 Quiet Subcommittee so the Noise Office invited Dave Smith and Kelly Sweeney to participate
37 on the Fly Quiet subcommittee to work with Steve Kerman.
