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Location change: Port of Portland Commission meets Jan. 11 at Port headquarters

The Port of Portland Commission will meet at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday at the Port headquarters building, 7200 N.E. Airport Way, Portland. This is a location change due to the possibility of winter weather. The Port offices provide the ability for commissioners to call in to the meeting should road conditions prove unsafe for them to travel to the meeting. The meeting location was previously scheduled in Hillsboro.

While monthly meetings are typically held in Portland, the special Hillsboro location was designed to give the community easier access to the Commission. In Washington County, the Port owns and operates Hillsboro Airport. It's expected a future meeting will be rescheduled at the Hillsboro location this spring.

Among agenda items for the meeting is a public hearing on the draft Port 2017 Transportation Improvement Plan. The plan identifies and prioritizes 5-, 10- and 20-year marine, air, road, rail, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian transportation improvement projects.
