# MINUTES SPECIAL COMMISSION MEETING THE PORT OF PORTLAND JUNE 24, 2009

In response to due notice, a special meeting of the Commissioners of the Port of Portland was held at 8:30 a.m. in the Commission Boardroom of the Port's administrative offices at 121 N.W. Everett Street.

### QUORUM

Commissioners present, via telephone connection, were Judi Johansen, President, presiding; Ken Allen; Peter Bragdon; Steve Corey; Diana Daggett; Bruce Holte; Mary Olson and Bill Thorndike. Also present were Steve Schreiber; Vince Granato, Chief Financial Officer; and participating staff members.

### **LEAVE OF ABSENCE**

Commissioner Johansen called for a motion to grant a leave of absence to Commissioner Rosenbaum who was out of town. Commissioner Holte moved to grant the leave of absence. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion, which was put to a roll call vote. Commissioners Allen, Bragdon, Corey, Holte, Johansen, Olson and Thorndike voted in favor of the motion. Commissioner Daggett was not present for the vote.

## **ACTION ITEMS**

### Agenda Item No. 1

APPROVAL OF ADJUSTMENTS TO THE APPROPRIATION LEVELS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008/2009

This agenda item requested approval of adjustments to the appropriation levels for the Port of Portland Fiscal Year 2008-09 Budget to reflect expected expenditure levels.

Vince Granato requested approval of the Executive Director's recommendations as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, That in accordance with ORS 294.450, the Port of Portland Commission finds the need to adjust appropriations within the General Fund in the amounts shown on Exhibit A and for the purposes shown on Exhibit B, incorporated by this reference, to meet actual spending patterns unforeseen at the time of adoption of the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of Exhibit A, Schedule of Appropriations Fiscal Year 2008-09; and Exhibit B, Explanation of Changes to Fund Appropriations Fiscal Year 2008-09, shall be included in the minutes of this meeting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Budget Officer is authorized to execute the necessary documents on behalf of the Port of Portland Commission in a form approved by counsel.

Following the presentation of the agenda item, Commissioner Johansen called for a motion to approve the recommendations. Commissioner Holte moved to approve the recommendations. Commissioner Thorndike seconded the motion, which was put to a roll call vote. Commissioners Allen, Bragdon, Corey, Daggett, Holte, Johansen, Olson and Thorndike voted in favor of the motion.

#### Agenda Item No. 2

### ADOPTION OF FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010 BUDGET

This agenda item requested adoption of the Port of Portland Budget for Fiscal Year 2008/2009.

Vince Granato requested approval of the Executive Director's recommendations as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Port of Portland Commission finds as follows:

- 1. The Port of Portland has, in the time and manner required by law, submitted its Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010, to the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission at the time and place fixed by the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission; and
- 2. No orders or objections were made by the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the amounts shown on Exhibit C, incorporated by this reference, are hereby appropriated for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2009, in a total amount of \$833,937,983; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of Exhibit C, Schedule of Appropriations Fiscal Year 2009-10, shall be attached to the minutes of this meeting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Budget for Fiscal Year 2009-10 in the total amount of \$861,576,448 is hereby adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Budget Officer is authorized to execute the necessary documents on behalf of the Port of Portland Commission in a form approved by counsel

Following presentation of the agenda item, Commissioner Johansen called for a motion to approve the recommendations. Commissioner Olson moved to approve the recommendations. Commissioner Bragdon seconded the motion, which was put to a roll call vote. Commissioners Allen, Bragdon, Corey, Daggett, Holte, Johansen, Olson and Thorndike voted in favor of the motion.
