Port and TSA Outreach to PDX Airport Workers

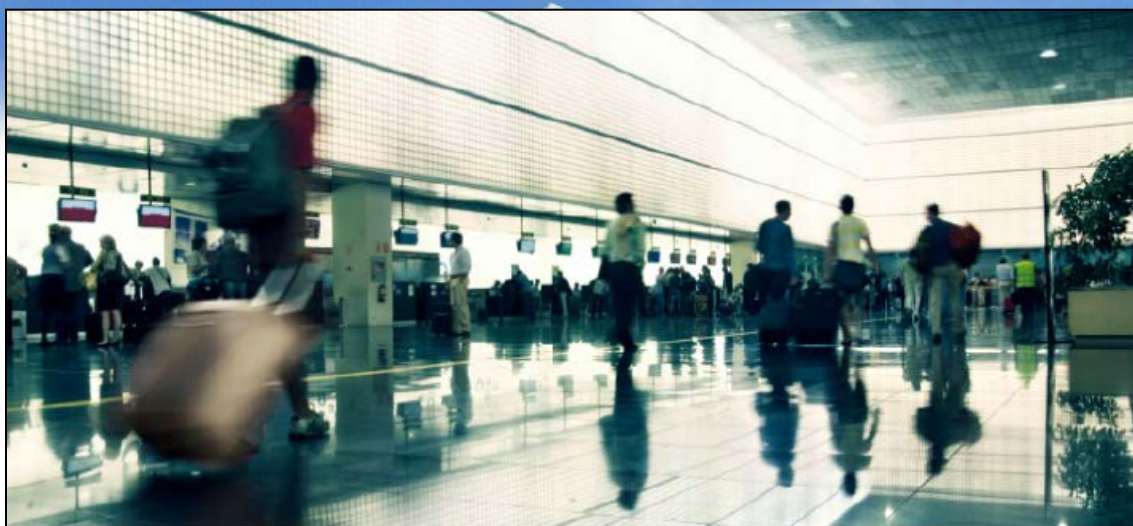
- Raise Employee Awareness
