







Temporary MAX System Map

MAX Detours and Shuttle Bus Service

August 21 – September 3, Blue and Red lines will be detoured and Green Line will not travel west of Lloyd Center. All MAX lines will run at reduced frequency and three MAX stations will close. Shuttle bus service will connect the Rose Quarter area and Lloyd Center and serve stops near closed stations (see details and map on reverse). Shuttle buses will also provide direct service between the airport and Kenton/N Denver Ave Station. Extra trains will circle the Transit Mall on 5th and 6th avenues.

MAX Blue Line

Hillsboro – Interstate/ Rose Quarter

Blue Line trains will travel their normal route between Hillsboro and Portland City Center. After crossing the Steel Bridge, trains will serve Interstate/Rose Quarter MAX Station.

To continue east of Rose Quarter, transfer to MAX shuttle bus at Interstate/Rose Quarter and connect with Blue or Green lines at Lloyd Center/NE 11th Ave.

Gresham - Lloyd Center

Blue Line trains will travel between Gresham and Lloyd Center/ NE 11th Ave. To continue to Downtown Portland, Beaverton, or Hillsboro transfer to MAX shuttle bus at Lloyd Center and connect with Blue, Red or Yellow lines at Interstate/ Rose Ouarter.

MAX Green LineClackamas – Lloyd Center

Green Line trains will operate between Clackamas Town Center and Lloyd Center/NE 11th Ave. Green Line will not run into Downtown Portland.

To continue to Downtown Portland, transfer to MAX shuttle bus at Lloyd Center and connect with Blue, Red or Yellow lines at Interstate/Rose Quarter.

MAX Red Line

Beaverton – Expo Center

Red Line trains will travel their normal route between Beaverton and Portland City Center. After crossing the Steel Bridge, trains will serve Interstate/ Rose Quarter MAX Station and then continue to Expo Center, serving Yellow Line stations.

To travel to the airport, connect with MAX airport shuttle bus at Kenton/N Denver Ave (Stop ID 2957).

To continue east of the Rose Quarter, connect with MAX shuttle bus at Interstate/Rose Quarter and connect with Blue or Green lines at Lloyd Center/ NE 11th Ave.

Airport – Gateway

Red Line trains will travel between Portland International Airport and Gateway Transit Center. Red Line will not run between Gateway and Lloyd Center. At Gateway, Red Line trains will use the center platform for trips to the airport.

MAX Orange and Yellow Line

Expo Center – Milwaukie

Orange and Yellow lines will travel their normal routes with reduced frequency.

Heading to the Airport?

Customers traveling from all points east of and including Lloyd Center, take any train to Gateway to transfer to Red Line. For all other locations, take Red Line to Kenton/N Denver Ave and transfer to MAX airport shuttle bus.

MAX Airport Shuttle Bus

Kenton - Airport

MAX airport shuttle buses will connect with the Red Line at Kenton/
N Denver Ave Station. Buses will travel direct between Portland International Airport and Kenton for the duration of Red Line service each day.

At Kenton/N Denver Ave, board shuttle bus one block southeast of MAX Station at N Interstate & Fenwick (Stop ID 2957). At the airport, shuttles will serve a temporary stop on the lower arrivals level, at south end of center service island (Stop ID 10181).

Leaving the Airport?

Customers traveling to Downtown Portland, Beaverton, or locations along Orange and Yellow lines, take MAX airport shuttle bus from the airport to Kenton/N Denver Ave and transfer to Red or Yellow lines. For other destinations, board Red Line trains at the airport and transfer to Blue or Green lines at Gateway.
