Pentachlorophenol

Pentachlorophenol, also known as PCP or "penta," is a manufactured chemical which was previously widely used as a pesticide. It is now restricted substance only used as an industrial wood preservative.

Potential Sources of Pentachlorophenol

- Treated wood, such as:
 - Old utility poles
 - Fender pilings
 - Landscaping timbers
 - Fences
 - Cribbing underneath docks or foundations

Best Management Practices

- Properly dispose of treated wood.
- Use treated wood only in areas that drain to soil (rather than surface water).
- Collect dust or debris released by treated wood material.
