Have you ever wondered how the weather affects solar energy production in the Pacific Northwest? Check real-time data at Portland International Airport to see how it changes. PDX has 292 photovoltaic panels providing energy to airport operations.

Travelers can view 140 solar panels above the airport terminal's upper roadway that power the Nike Store.



Deicing Stormwater Treatment Facility

120 panels (33.9 KWp)

32 panels (6.3 KWp)

152 panels power the PDX deicing stormwater treatment facility. The state-of-the-art facility treats and stores 31 million gallons of deicing stormwater.
