The Port of Portland was honored to play a small part in supporting the local nonprofit **SnowCap Community Charities**, which is providing critical food resources to those in need right now. Their demand is so great as everyone works to stop the spread of COVID-19, SnowCap needed more storage urgently.

The city of **Gresham** reached out to us over the weekend, and we quickly found two shipping containers and chassis thanks to partners at **Portland Container** and transportation provided by **Shippers Transport Express**. They were delivered to SnowCap on Monday and will be used to fill about 1,900 food-boxes.
